

## Massachusetts's EMAC Announcement - DO NOT ASSIGN CCC

MA recently announced Employer Medical Assistance Contributions Supplement (EMAC). Massachusetts notified employers and provided a link on the MA UI on-line website allowing them to assign their third party provider (TPA) to several roles. **CCC should not be assigned to these roles. CCC does not provide any support to EMAC.**

### The details:

An EMAC Supplement only applies if the non-disabled employee was enrolled in Mass Health (excluding the premium assistance program) or subsidized coverage through the Massachusetts ConnectorCare program for more than eight weeks during the quarter. The contribution is 5% of annual wages for each non-disabled employee, up to the annual wage cap of \$15,000, for a maximum of \$750 per affected employee per year. The contribution does not apply to employees who earn less than \$500 in wages per quarter.

The contributions collected will help offset the Commonwealth's cost of providing health insurance to employees. This supplemental contribution only applies to those employees on state-subsidized coverage. Below is the link on the website for review.
